


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Why Madeira is so Iconic?

Climate



These islands, because of their privileged geographical position and mountainous relief, have a surprisingly mild climate. Very mild average temperatures, 22°C in the summer and 16°C in the winter, and a moderate level of humidity, confer upon these islands exceptional subtropical features. The seawater temperature is also very mild, because of the influence of the warm Gulf current, presenting averages of 22°C in the summer and 18° in the winter.

Belmond Reid's Palace



Group Activities



A Memorable Tour city Highlights

Discover the hidden charms of the city through the renown Old town, then winding its way to the charming market "Mercado dos Lavradores", where ladies dressed in typical costumes sell the exotic flowers produced on the island. On the lower floor the smell of fresh fish attracts clients to see the 'catch of the day', where the "espada" - black scabbard fish is the most popular. Next stop is at the lace factory where one of the most famous handicraft in the world is made. Last but not least, a visit to one of our wine lodges will delight our guests with the different kinds of Madeira wine. From the driest to the sweetest all turn common occasions into a special one. Now we're going to appreciate the beauty of Madeira by taking the cable car to Monte. For the more adventurous of the group, we suggest descending on the legendary toboggan.





The Panoramic East camacha & Santana

Driving up the mountain we reach 'Pico do Arieiro', the second highest mountain from the island (1810m). Ribeiro Frio will be the next stop. In the heart of the 'Laurissilva' forest, a gorgeous garden surrounds the trout hatchery. From here you will have the opportunity to make a short walk to "Balcões" (1h30 walk) to enjoy the magnificent views over the deep valleys surrounded by steep mountains. At the end group will have the opportunity to taste a typical drink "Poncha". Finally, we arrive at Santana, probably the most typical village on the island, where still today some of the peculiar thatching roof houses can be found. Stop for Lunch. The last stop is at 'Machico', a town built between the mountain and the sea, actually the 'birthplace' of the island. The place where the Portuguese sailors arrived for the first





time in 1419.

Enchanting Valleys

Eíra do Serrado & Curral das Freíras

This half day excursion leads to Pico dos Barcelos at 1100 ft above the sea level, from where one can get a fantastic view over the town, bay and surrounding hills.

A twisted road, bordered with eucalyptus reaches Eira do Serrado (lookout point) overlooking "Curral das Freiras", a peculiar village built in a deep valley, taken for centuries as the crater of an ancient volcano. At the end the whole group will be taken back to the hotel.





Check in for Adventure JeepTour

Not far from Funchal hidden in between high mountains and deep valleys lie remote villages and hamlets such as Jardim da Serra with its splendid view over the Nuns valley. Locate another world by joining us on a Land Rover tour with panoramic views, interesting places and sensational encounters with Madeira 's natural heritage.

The World of Blue whale & Dolphin Watching

This is a unique opportunity to be both out in the open water and to get very close to sea life. The boat sits low on the water (inflatable boat) so guests will be close enough to touch the dolphins swimming all around.

A marine biologist accompanies the group and provides interesting stories about the animals and their ocean habitat. Lookouts are strategically placed on mountains overlooking the sea and direct the captain to dolphin and whale locations for optimal viewing experiences.

Optional Activities



Hiking on top of the hill Pico Areeiro to Pico Ruivo

Hiking to the summit of Pico Ruivo, Madeira's highest point, from its second-highest point, Pico do Arieiro, is a stunning and beautiful way to spend a day on this glorious island.

With a wonderful view, this trail has the peculiarity of connecting two of the highest peaks of Madeira Island, the Pico Ruivo (1862m) and the Pico do Arieiro (1818m), traveling to that part of the area of the Central Mountain Massif.

Between some ascents and descents, it is important to arrive at Pico ruivo where you will find a steep ascent along hundreds of steps carved inside the rock and a meticulous descent. This is a suitable trail for lovers of flora and fauna and physical challenges.

Our adventure ends when we drop you back off at the meeting point, thrilled and satisfied at having conquered the highest point on the island and seen the best this special place has to offer.





For Mature Lovers Levadas

For nature lovers, walking alongside a levada is one of the most unique experiences to have while staying in Madeira. "But what are levadas?", you may ask.

These are man-made channels created to carry water for irrigation of agricultural fields around the island. But such watercourses are not unique to Madeira: what is unique is their accessibility and extent. You need only venture a little way off the main roads to begin to appreciate Madeira's myriad aqueducts - for their beauty, ingenuity of design and for the courage and determination needed to bring the concept to its present glory.

Follow the water channels and let yourself be guided through the breathtaking landscapes of mountains and abysses.





Pure Adrenaline coasteering

It is a relatively new sport, which is progressing along the zone between the tides of a rocky shore, using the swim, climb, rappel, jump into the water and walk.

Coasteering is a recent activity in Madeira, where you will find the best spots for practicing this sport, because it combines the surroundings of natural protected area with the blue and green of translucent waters and magnificent rocky escarpments that plunge over bays and coves that characterize this landscape.





Into The Wildlife canyoning

Let us take you on a thrilling adventure by crossing the canyons of the "Madeira Laurissilva Forest". Our voyagers will have to climb, jump, rappel, swim, cross waterfalls with a rope and mountaineering equipment in order to complete this mission.

Before starting this quest an in-depth briefing and skilled guide will be done. (this activity requires a high level of fitness) Important note: guests must take their swimsuits



Ocean Experience sup

SUP or Stand Up Paddle Surfing is a new worldwide booming sport. Through this new activity, we intend to provide a different view of Madeira Island from a sea view perspective. The tours are held in the sea with SUP Boards, wherein you may access the local beauty and lush landscape, often merely limited to other vessel types.

This is an activity that is gaining adherents, to be fun, easy to learn, and a complete physical activity.

SUP is an excellent workout option of fitness, since it allows to strengthen the arms, legs and abdomen. The practice of SUP also improved the balance and concentration.





End of the Island

Ponta São Lourenço walk

Visiting some of the finest cliff scenery on Madeira, this walk explores the long thin peninsula at the eastern end of the island. The paths are good but undulating - whether you get close to the edges is up to you. The trail follows S. Lourenço Point, the eastern-most peninsula of Madeira island. In the sea, you may be lucky enough to spot the world's rarest seal, known in Madeira as a Sea-wolf (Monachus)At the end of the trail, at Sardinha port, speed boats will be waiting for the group to ride back to Funchal. On the way back it is very probable that the group will spot the ocean's while life as whales, dolphins or orcas.





Exploring the Ocean Nau Santa Maria

Embark in "Nau de Santa Maria de Colombo" sailing along the coast of Madeira in the Santa Maria will take you back to the 15th century.

Sail along the south west coast to Cabo Girão, the highest sea cliff from Europe (580 m).

Guests will enjoy the beauty of the Madeira coastline aboard on a historic ship of Christopher Columbus.

There is a strong possibility of watching the many forms of Madeira sea life, such as Dolphins, whales and turtles at close range.

Wood Fire Cooking casa das Espetadas

Location: Funchal

Located 100 meters from the hotel Vidamar, the Casa das Espetadas Restaurant specializes in traditional Wood Fire cooking with Madeira Folklore and Fado entertainment. The food is certainly worth travelling for, and many people do. The attraction is a combination of a local meeting point, the Islands favorite Poncha (Local tradional drink) and a menu that keeps on giving. The one price menu is definitely a draw, while local Madeira produce is championed relentlessly – an impressive roster of local suppliers is clearly visible. Traditional eaters go for the classic beef espetada, Chicken, tuna, pork, or other seasonal specialties. The islands favorite Bolo do Caco (local traditional bread with garlic butter) is made in front of your eyes and cooked next to the open wood fire. Don't miss the traditional folklore and the popular Fado.





Traditional Dinner o Lagar Restaurant

Location: Camara de Lobos

Surrounded by vineyards on the southern slopes of the main wine producing area of Madeira. Once arrived at "O Lagar" Restaurant, you'll be welcome in a rustic and pleasant environment.

The restaurant features traditional Madeira food, namely the famous "espetada" (meat kebab), which are freshly grilled steaks cubed, skewered and hung from a spit.

Over dinner, it is optionally possible to assist to a local folklore performance, giving the opportunity for guests to be experience this Island cultural heritage and even learn a couple dance steps.





On the fishing village vila do Peixe

Location: Camara de Lobos

We can start with aperitif in one of the bars of the heart of Câmara de Lobos. Then group walk to the restaurant that overlooks this picturesque fishing village with its many colorful fishing boats docked in the harbor.

The restaurant reflects the best traditions of grilling the day's catch by the sea. Using only the freshest of fish, it is prepared in the simplest form (with rock salt and a little olive oil), and grilled over the open fire embers.

The environment is a mixture between modern and rustic, providing a very unique atmosphere. A large room, decorated in wood and dark-brown, gives access to the open kitchen area, where everything is done under the view of the customer.

On the top of the cliff

Estalagem Ponta do Sol

Location: Ponta do Sol

UNÍQUE & Special place Blandy's Wine Loge

The lodge was bought by John Blandy in the mid-19th century and not only was it an extremely valuable property.

Each one of the Lodge's rooms has its own character and due to the differing temperatures and humidity, the wines all have differing ageing profiles based on their location.

The Vintage room is the cathedral of Blandy's rarest and oldest Madeira wines, where wines dating from the beginning of the 20th century can be tasted, such as Blandy's Bual 1920.

Today the Blandy's Wine Lodge is the heart of the family's wine business where over 650 barrels and vats are stored, ageing the finest of the family's wines in the traditional canteiro method.

There are 3 rooms for privet events, a museum and a special room for wine tasting experiences.













Dinner in an Islet Design Centre Nini

The Design Centre Nini Andrade Silva is located in the city of Funchal at the emblematic building known locally as "Molhe" – Fortaleza da Nossa Senhora da Conceição, which was once the home of Gonçalves Zarco, an old Portuguese sea navigator and colonizer of the Archipelago of Madeira.

The Design Centre Nini Andrade Silva is a place of meeting and sharing - a laboratory of ideas - with a unique spatial valences, such as a permanent exhibition area, shop, cafeteria and a restaurant on the top with gorgeous views over the bay of Funchal.

The restaurant unveils smells and flavors in a relaxed merger between well receiving and the reinventing of the Portuguese cuisine.


